FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Purpose? The Governors' Seminar is the third in a series — GNATS, GETS and GOVERNORS' SEMINAR — and is considered “continuing education” that adds to your knowledge and experience with just-in-time information, and provides an opportunity to talk with key leaders on issues of concern to you.

Where am I supposed to be, at what time? Check in at Institute Registration beginning at 7:30am on the Terrace outside the Monterey Grand Ballroom (near the lobby). Packets contain badges and seating assignments for Thurs. and Sat. evenings. We start at 8:45am in the Windjammer Rooms with time for meeting and having a cup of coffee or tea, before we begin at 9:00am sharp. We will conclude at 4:15.
